An Ordinance regulating the shooting
 of fire Crackers or other Explosives.

Sec 1

Be it Ordained By the President and Board
 of Trustees of the Village of Hampton that
 Beginning with the tenth day after the
 Posting of this Ordinance it shall Be
 unlawful for any Person or Persons
 either adult or minor or any Person who
 so ever to fire or cause to Be fired, any
 Fire Crackers, Giant Crackers, Dynamite
 Crackers, or any other Explosives of any
 nature whatever on the Streets or
 Alleys of the afore said Village before
 the third day of July of any year, and
 ending with the evening of the fifth
 day of July.

Sec 2

The shooting of Dynamite Crackers
 is Expressly forbidden at any and all times.

Sec 3

Beginning with the hour of 5 O'clock
 in the morning of the 3rd of July
 and ending with the hour of 10 O'clock
 of the 5th day of July of any year it
 shall Be lawful to fire any of the
 common fourth of July fire works
 except as above noted

Sec 4

It shall Be unlawful for any Person
 or Persons that ever to fire any Ex-
 plosive at or near any horse or team
 of horses being driven through.

the Village or where any horses may Be hitched in the limits of said Village which shall cause any Horse or horses to become scared or cause them to run away and cause damage and annoyance to the owner of said horses or any Person who shall fire or cause to be fired any Explosives against or on the roof of any Building what ever or on or against any other Property of any nature what ever, where said Explosives are liable to cause damage by fire or who shall fire or cause to be fired Explosive against the Body or under the feet of any Person in the Village to their discomfort and annoyance, shall Be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall Be fined in a sum not less than One dollar nor more than five dollars for the first Offence and for each and every subsequent offence a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty dollars shall Be imposed.

Sec 5. Any Person Violating any of the Provisions of this Ordinance who shall Be convicted of causing any damage, either By the Bra king loose of any Horse or Horses and causing them to run away or causing any Horse or Horses which are being driven through the Village to run away or who shall cause any damage By fire to any Property what ever in said Village shall Be held liable for the full amount of damage so caused to the owner or owners of said Property so damaged if the Person causing said damage be an adult or if the person causing any damage within the Provisions of this section shall Be a minor then said minors Parents shall Be held liable for the full amount of damage so caused.

Sec 6 The manner of Collecting damages under this section shall be the same as provided by State law for the collection of any Debt.
